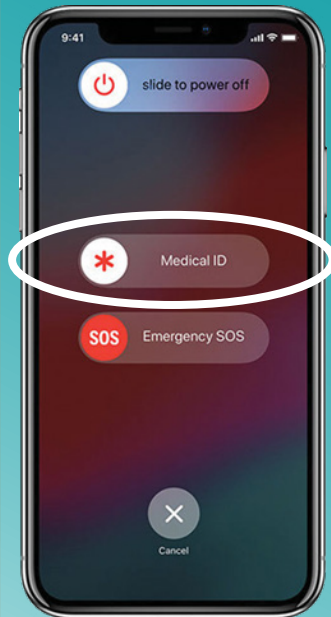

Set up your Medical ID

1. Find and open the Health app.
2. Tap the Summary tab.
3. Tap your profile picture in the upper-right corner.
4. At the top, tap Medical ID.
5. Tap Edit in the upper-right corner.
6. To make your Medical ID available from the Lock screen on your iPhone, scroll to the bottom and turn on Show When Locked. In an emergency, this gives information to people who want to help.
7. Enter health information like your date of birth, allergies, medicines, and blood type.
8. Tap Done.



Add Emergency Contacts

1. Find and open the Health app.
2. Tap your profile picture in the upper-right corner.
3. At the top, tap Medical ID.
4. Tap Edit, then scroll to Emergency Contacts.
5. Tap the Plus button (+) next to “add emergency contact.” Tap a contact, then add their relationship.
6. To remove a contact, tap the red circle next to the contact, then tap Delete.
7. Tap Done.
